NEW BUSINESS:

M.O. No. 44, Series 2007 – Approving Bills Over \$500.00. Introduced by Mr. McDonald. Motion by Ms. Mayes, second by Ms. Burton. All ayes.

Mr. McDonald said he would like to point out the reason the grand total is over \$775,000 for the month is: Flynn Brothers for \$231,000 was for street paving and \$211,000 of that came out of the MAP fund which is State funds we receive. Also, Anthem BC/BS for over \$68,000 is for insurance and Wagner Electric for over \$18,000.00 is for lighting for the walking path which most of that was paid out of the walking path account. He just wanted to clarify these large amounts.

Chief Miller reported he and the Mayor went to Elizabethtown to attend a ceremony awarding the Shively Police Department a \$25,000.00 “Highway Safety Grant” which will be used for impaired drivers and traffic enforcement. Another grant the Mayor just signed was \$12,600 which will be used for radar equipment and portable breathalyzers, and the grant for \$13,154 for GTSI on the bill list is for the in-car computers. The

Highway Safety Grant will begin November 1, 2007 and will run for one year depending on the statistics we get.

Mayor Conner reported on the game the Shively Sluggers played against the WAMZ Hamz. Unfortunately we lost by one run but, \$911.00 was raised and the proceeds will go to St. Jude's Children's Hospital.

CITIZENS PARTICIPATION:

Mr. Alphonza Bradley, 3200 Hampstead Court complained about neighbors still parking in front yards and also garbage cans are being left out. He also complained about a dump truck parked in the front yard at 3204 Hampstead Court.

Mayor Conner said our ordinance does not state garbage cans have to be placed in the back of the house they just have to be taken in.

Ms. Carol Hickman, Shively Code Enforcement Board said they are sitting in the front yard and they can put them on the side of the house.

Mr. Carl Chapman, Shively Code Enforcement Board said the garbage cans are on the side porch because of the way the garage is attached to the house.

Mayor Conner told Mr. Bradley we'll try to help you out.

Mayor Conner reminded everyone about the town meeting Mary Woolridge is having tomorrow night at 6:00 p.m. at Hill Street Baptist Church regarding the wet/dry vote issue. Some of the council members and I plan on attending.

Mr. McDonald read some of the article Ms. Woolridge had written in the Louisville Defender.

Chief Wendell Vincent reported on October 7, 2007 at 3:00 p.m. the Shively Sluggers will play Mother's Cookies as a fundraiser for Mother's Cookies. All proceeds will go to the Metro United Way.

Mr. Miller then asked Mr. Kenny Young, ABC Administrator how many alcohol beverage licenses do we have in Shively?

Mr. Young said about 12.

Mayor Conner said Ms. Roberson said approximately 30 and she can provide you a complete list.

Mr. Miller said if those establishments that cannot serve anymore and want to move into Shively that will cause us to become an oasis.

Mayor Conner said I'm not so sure that's exactly what we want to be and we don't the problems that they were obviously having to gravitate to us. On the other hand, I would not like to see us become a dry city either.

Ms. Burton also said she received a compliment on the Mayor from a friend saying she is glad for the Mayor's progress she has made. Also, there is a lot of noise coming from the Dixie Fast Mart on Mary Catherine Drive and a police officer drove past it and didn't check it out. There is also an issue on basketball goals on Model Road. Lastly, there will be a Breast Cancer Awareness Walk on October 28, 2007 downtown.

Mayor Conner said she appreciates those kind words but, I cannot say I do all this by myself it takes a lot of work and changes made, progress made it's a lot of people coming together.
