### **CITIZENS PARTICIPATION:**

Mr. Ernie Holman, 4033 Chevoit Drive said he talked with the State Highway Department three weeks ago regarding the turning lane at Chevoit Drive and Crums Lane and thanked them for marking the roadway with arrows. He was told Mr. Sanders from the Highway Department who was our contact person has retired. He also complained about the traffic problem when leaving the Watterson Expressway onto Garris Lane. Also said Chase Bank has a special for senior citizens. They will let you refinance your home with no closing costs and asked if this could be put in the next newsletter. He also asked how will people who don't drive get to the walking path once it is built?

Mr. Alphoza Bradley, 3200 Hampstead Drive showed pictures of a white van to the Mayor and City Council. Where this van parks blocks his recycling bin to where the Works Department cannot see it to empty it. Also showed pictures of where water stands in his neighborhood. There's also a large tree where branches are on the power lines and there is trash in the water. He also complained about the street light.

Mayor Conner asked does the white van stay there all the time – it never gets moved.

Mr. Bradley said yes.

Mayor Conner asked if he needed the pictures back.

Mr. Bradley said no.

Mr. Ricardo Aguayo, 3306 Wessel Road said the minutes from July 17<sup>th</sup> are not on the website. Also asked if the city could cold patch the pothole in front of his house and asked if the street paving list is complete because the holes are getting deeper.

Mayor Conner said we are compiling our street list that we are going to pave but the paving probably won't be done until the spring.

Mr. Aguayo also said since the recent rain, water stands in his driveway that has a hole on the side.

Mayor Conner said we can probably cold patch that.

Mr. Aguayo also said according to Sunday's newspaper, there was an article about sirens which said they are actually meant to notify anyone inside their house not outside then asked if Shively was going to get additional sirens so more people can hear it.

Mayor Conner said she has a map shows where they are all at and they cost about \$18,000 to have them installed so that has to be put in the budget.

Mr. Mitch Perry introduced himself to everyone. He is running for Circuit Court Judge, Division 3 and said this year every judicial officer in the state is on the ballot. Also said he and Mr. Silverthorn are not running against each other.

Mr. Bob Silverthorn also introduced himself to everyone. He is running for Circuit Court Judge Division 6.
