Mayor Conner said random and is for all departments except for the works department because they are already doing it with the Department of Transportation because of the CDL's they have to have.

Mr. Dummitt said so it will include all the other departments.

Mayor Conner said yes and we can make the municipal order say what we want to include the elected officials as well.

Mr. Dummitt said I know it is not in the fire department's contract but is this a parts of right to manage type of thing or do we have to get approval from the unions?

Mayor Conner said I don't think we need approval and we do have the right to manage which is in all the union contracts.

Mr. Dummitt said if we do this and start firing employees, the union would fight it so would this have to be negotiated?

Ms. Burton asked is there anything in the contracts saying this could possibly happen?

Mayor Conner said what we need to do is come up with a policy.

Major Kleier said he hasn't heard any police officers say they are against it.

Chief Vincent said if this is enacted, it should pertain to anyone who draws a paycheck from the city.

Mr. Dummitt then said the council don't drive the big vehicles and carry guns where we would put other people's lives at stake either, but he wouldn't have a problem taking one.
